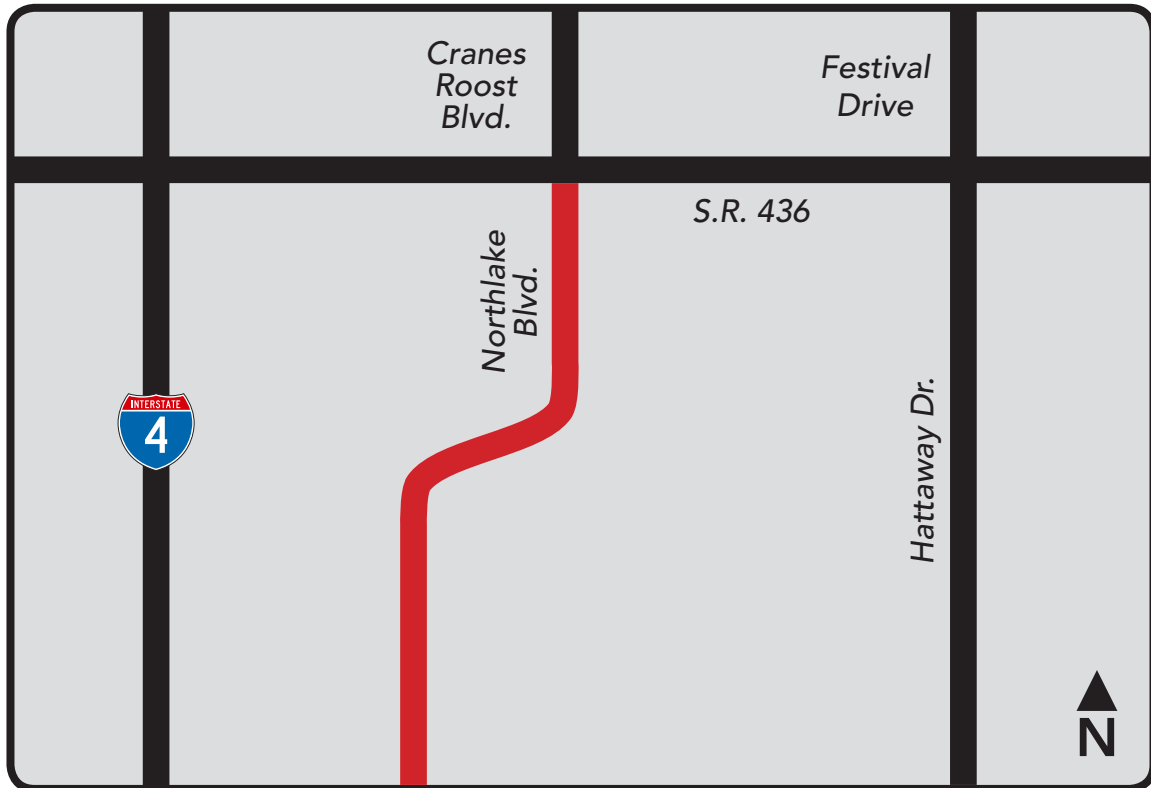




Northlake Blvd. Improvement Project



The City of Altamonte Springs is initiating street improvements to the Northlake Boulevard corridor starting the week of February 13. The project is scheduled to finish by September 2017.

This project is providing a new continuous 8-foot sidewalk from the southern terminus of the roadway to S.R. 436. The project also includes pavement reconstruction, new raised medians, hardscaping, landscaping, irrigation and new decorative lighting, along with improved north-side alignment at the intersection of S.R. 436 and Cranes Roost Boulevard. These renovations will provide an enhanced connection for cyclists and pedestrians to the Cranes Roost area.

The City has contracted Atlantic Civil Constructors for this project. Their initial work consists of surveying the corridor and locating utilities. Upon completion, they will focus on west-side roadway construction starting at the S.R. 436 intersection and working south. The City will maintain two-way traffic as much as possible utilizing the existing center two-way left turn lane. If single laning is required, it will not occur during morning or afternoon peak times (6 to 9 a.m. and 4 to 7 p.m.). The contractor is authorized to work on Saturdays from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m., if needed to meet the overall project schedule. No work will occur on Sundays. The City will coordinate the work with the street corridor driveways and provide a minimum 48-hour notice to the designated property contacts.
