



# Red Hot & Boom 2019 Traffic Information

## CLOSURES

- Road closures on July 2:
  - Cranes Roost Boulevard will close at 9 a.m. between Uptown Boulevard and Festival Drive.
  - Centerpointe Circle closes at 10 a.m.
  - Uptown Boulevard is closed to thru traffic starting at 4 p.m.
  - Cranes Roost Boulevard will close at 4 p.m. between Shorecrest Drive and Festival Drive.
- Road closures on July 3:
  - The rear entrance to the Altamonte Mall on Festival Drive closes at 8 a.m.
  - Festival Drive will close at 8 a.m. between the Altamonte Mall Loop Road and Central Parkway.
  - Cranes Roost Boulevard is closed at S.R. 436 starting at 6:30 p.m.

**Note: All affected roads are scheduled to reopen on July 4 at 2 a.m.**

## TRAFFIC TIPS

- Both the Altamonte Mall parking garages are closed and unavailable for general parking.
- Handicap parking is available in the parking lot near Festival Drive and Central Parkway.
- In general, making a right turn is easier than making a left turn. In many places, left turns and U-turns are restricted after the fireworks.
- Sometimes, it's better to take the longer route around the most congested areas before heading toward your final destination.
- Use the map and consider how you are required to turn before deciding where to park.
- If you find yourself making a turn you didn't plan on, you can make a turn toward your destination on another major road in about two to three miles. Consider an alternate route in advance. Print out a copy of the traffic flow map and take it with you.
- For the best travel results, use the map to pick alternate routes that flow away from the I-4/S.R. 436 area.
- The fireworks end around 10 p.m. and most traffic routes are flowing normally by 11:30 p.m.

## RECOMMENDED ROUTES

### Altamonte Springs

- If you live west of I-4, consider taking Central Parkway to Montgomery Road.
- If you live east of I-4, you will not be able to directly cross S.R. 436 between Palm Springs Drive and I-4 and left turns are slow. Consider going to Boston Avenue or Maitland Avenue and making a right turn.

### Orlando

- S.R. 436 from the Altamonte Mall to I-4 is very crowded. Consider alternate routes.
- S.R. 436 to Maitland Avenue and 17-92 are less crowded. Consider taking Maitland Avenue to Maitland Boulevard, then take I-4 or 17-92 toward Orlando.
- Taking Central Parkway and turning on Montgomery Road toward S.R. 434 to reach I-4 is less crowded, and easier to access than S.R. 436. It might seem out of the way, but depending on where you park, it will likely be quicker.

### Maitland/Winter Park

- Plan where you park. Going east on S.R. 436 toward Casselberry is limited to traffic coming off Palm Springs Drive and from areas on the south side of S.R. 436.
- Consider taking S.R. 436 to Maitland Avenue or 17-92 and then south to your destination.

### Sanford/Deltona/Daytona Beach

- S.R. 436 from Altamonte Mall to I-4 is very crowded. Getting onto I-4 will take more time. Consider alternate routes.
- Taking Central Parkway and turning on Montgomery Road toward S.R. 434 to reach I-4 is less crowded, and easier to access than S.R. 436.

### Longwood/Winter Springs

- Palm Springs northbound to S.R. 434 is very crowded. Taking Central Parkway and making a right at Montgomery Road to reach S.R. 434 may be a better option.
- Taking Central Parkway and making a right on Montgomery Road to head toward S.R. 434 may be better for those living west of I-4 in unincorporated Seminole County.
- S.R. 436 to 17-92 is probably better if you are going toward Winter Springs or Oviedo.

### Apopka/West Orange County

- S.R. 436 is very crowded from the Altamonte Mall to I-4. Consider taking Central Parkway and making a left on Montgomery Road to head toward S.R. 436.
- If you are forced east on S.R. 436, go to Maitland Avenue, then south to Maitland Boulevard, then back west to S.R. 441.
