SUMMER CAMP

Altamonte Springs Recreation is offering a supervised summer camp program that includes ten weekly sessions for children ages 8 to 14 who are Altamonte Springs residents. Camp runs Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Weekly sessions begin June 1 with the last session starting August 2. There is no camp July 5. Daily activities include sports, games, swimming, arts and crafts, movies and special guests.

STAFF

Summer camp staff meets the City of Altamonte Springs' screening standards, which includes a level two national background check. All staff members are certified through the American Red Cross in first aid and CPR/AED. The counselor-to-camper ratio is 1 to 16.

REGISTRATION

Campers are divided into co-ed groups of 16 campers. To ensure the safety of the camp, registration is limited to 64 campers per week. The program is limited to Altamonte Springs residents residing within the city limits. Registration is required for each weekly session. All participants must register by 12 p.m. the Friday prior to each session. Cost is \$90 per weekly session. (Note: Cost for the July 5 session is \$75 due to a four-day week.)

DROP OFF/PICK-UP

Campers should be dropped off between 8 and 9 a.m. All parents are required to park their vehicle and walk their child to the main building entrance for check in. Special arrangements must be made for drop off after 9 a.m. by contacting camp staff at (407) 468-2159. Campers should be picked up between 4 and 5 p.m. All parents are to park their vehicle and walk to the main building entrance for check out. Parents of children who need to be picked up prior to 4 p.m. should check in at the Westmonte Recreation Center front office.

FIELD TRIPS

Field trips are not scheduled as part of this year's summer camp program. As an alternative, special guests are scheduled to visit Westmonte weekly.

POOL USAGE

Campers are allowed to use the pool twice weekly between 12 and 2 p.m. on select Tuesdays and Thursdays (weather permitting). The pool is reserved for summer camp participants during scheduled swim times. No additional fee is required.

LUNCH & SNACKS

Camper break for lunch from 11 to 11:30 a.m. They must bring a lunch from home as concessions are not available for purchase. Lunches can be stored in a small cooler or container. Campers also have snack breaks before and after lunch. Snacks must be brought from home and stored in a small cooler or container.



HEALTH & SAFETY GUIDELINES

The City of Altamonte Springs is committed to keeping participants and staff safe and healthy during this unprecedented time. To prevent the spread of COVID-19, we have prepared a list of guidelines.

Camp Staff

- Staff who are feeling ill or have symptoms of COVID-19 will stay home.
- Staff will carry sanitizer at all times.
- Staff will follow CDC guidelines for vaccinated and non-vaccinated individuals.
- Staff will promote healthy hygiene including frequent and proper hand washing, use of hand sanitizer and covering of coughs or sneezes with a tissue or inside of elbow.
- Staff will practice proper hand hygiene and respiratory etiquette.
- Staff will enhance cleaning and disinfecting schedules and procedures.

Camp Participants

- Campers who are feeling ill or have symptoms of COVID-19 should stay home.
- Campers who are feeling ill or showing symptoms related to COVID-19 while at camp, will be isolated from the group, and the parent will be contacted to pick up their child.
- Parents are asked to self-report any instances of positive COVID-19 cases of registered campers as well as any contact the registered camper has had with any individual who has tested positive for COVID-19.
- Participants are urged to follow established guidance on personal hygiene, hand washing and hand sanitizer.
- Please be advised that the City is required to release participant names, dates of birth, address and phone numbers to Local, State and Federal agencies upon request as it relates to COVID-19 contact tracing efforts.
